

Reminders before we return to school on April 12th 2021

- Please complete the Return to School Declaration Form by Sunday 11th of April. This will be sent to you via text. If you do not receive the form, please email the school at rathvilly.ns@gmail.com and a form will be emailed to you.
- Please do not send your child/ren to school if they are unwell, show signs of Coronavirus or have come in contact with someone who has Coronavirus. If you have been outside of Ireland, your child must self-isolate for 14 days upon return.
- Children will be sent home immediately if they are unwell or show any signs or symptoms of Coronavirus. Please be available to take a call from the school.

- Please wear mask coverings while dropping and collecting your child/ren. This is in line with public health advice.
